First Harvest (9/1/2020)

September 1 was a historic day for our Wesley ministry. It was our First Harvest! Nearly three months of effort led to this day, and have also set the stage for other future harvests too. The SHSU Food Pantry had their ribbon-cutting ceremony right next door to us in February. We had a vision to use the green alleyway between our two buildings as the location for 12 vegetable garden beds. Thanks to missions funding from the West District of the UMC, we installed the watering system and 5 vegetable beds. Wesley and SHSU Food Pantry students have been daily watering them since July. The sole purpose of these veggie beds is to alleviate food insecurity on our college campus. Our veggie garden was also featured in 4 different publications, including the Huntsville newspaper, the Walker County magazine and the SHSU news network!

Our main purpose is to help college students discover the greater life in Jesus Christ. Many of our Wesley crew did not have a background in the church or the Christian faith before joining our Wesley. Jesus is certainly moving our ministry!







Covid-19 Couldn't Stop Us From Serving!



Throughout May and June, our students joined forces at the SHSU stadium with other volunteers to help the Houston Food Bank give away 364,700 pounds of food to 7,294 vehicles affected by the financial consequences from the response to Covid.



On multiple days in June, students of the Wesley and SHSU Food Pantry worked together to build Phase 1 of the Vege-



SHSU had 3 Move-In Days in August. We served over 400 people with free water, lemonade and snow cones in 100+ degrees heat.



Huntsville High School hosted evacuees from Hurricane Laura. Our Wesley donated water bottles and food items to help them.



Our August and September monthly offering helped us buy 30,000 sheets of paper to donate to a Huntsville school: Gibbs Pre-School.



We spent a Saturday morning helping sort and arrange at the Come Center Resale Shop (9/26/20).



We sent a team to First Methodist Huntsville to help them in their Saturday workdays at the church (9/19/20).



We helped unload 988 pumpkins at 1st Methodist for their annual Pumpkin Patch (9/29/20).



A Wesley alumnus from '95, serving in the National Guard, was serving evacuees at the Walker County Storm Shelter. He asked us if we could donate socks, and we did!



In early October, we sent two teams for different painting projects. One team went to New Waverly Elementary to repaint parking stripes. Another team went to Galilee Church of God to help paint the eves and their front door. Both projects came to our attention through Wesley students who asked the question: "What if this was something our team could do?" This Saturday project was a stand-alone effort of the Wesley.
