SHSU Leads with Distinction at All Campus Retreat 2023 (2/17-2/19/23)

Every year since the 1960s, the several Wesley Foundations gather for a weekend retreat together known as "All Campus Retreat." It is a weekend of 4 worship services, workshops led by the campus ministers, small groups for discussion, fun events like paintball, human foosball, silent disco, captive, neon dodgeball or just jamming as a group. Pastor Michael McVey was our guest preacher and brought the Heavenly Fire down for us! Resurrection Week 2023 (4/3/23)

Earlier this year, in February, God did amazing things on the Asbury University campus, and then spread the revival from there. Many college students hunger for an authentic relationship with Jesus Christ in this 21st Century. "Rez Week" was about helping to feed and nurture that hunger. On the Monday before Easter, nearly 120 students from eight different campus ministries combined efforts for a pizza dinner on the Wesley lawn, and an uplifting Spirit-filled worship service in a nearby amphitheater known as Old Main Pit (where SHSU's Old Main once stood). This year, the praise team was a combination of Wesley, Baptist Student Ministry and Kats for Christ. We closed with praying together in small groups, hand in hand, not as Methodists or Baptists, but as Christ-followers.
